Hereford

- *Bos taurus* – European breed
- Suited to cooler climates
- Medium-sized animal
- Thick coat
- Crossed with tropical cattle e.g. Brahmans to make a Braford

Brahman

- *Bos indicus* – tropical breed
- Suited to hot climates
- Large-sized animal
- Loose skin
- Crossed with European cattle e.g. Herefords to make a Braford
